

Leipzig — always a good choice

Leipzig is "Hype-zig" - and not just recently. The lively, busy trading city magically attracted people in former times already. When travelers approached Leipzig by train from the south, Bayerischer Bahnhof was the first thing they saw. The station was built in 1842 and for 70 years, until 1912, it had been the train stop for all trains from ... well, Bavaria (Bayern), of course!

Four gate-like arches, each featuring a square tower at the side: The porticus is hard to overlook. The trade fair city presented itself confidently to the travelers in times past and the ensemble of Bayerischer Bahnhof is just as unique in Leipzig's cityscape today. Being a striking piece of the city and transport history, the oldest preserved terminus station in the world is listed.

The new millennium marked the beginning of Bayerischer Bahnhof's new, second life – as Gasthaus and Gosebrauerei (restaurant and Gose brewery) Bayerischer Bahnhof it provides a cozy escape to anyone who's on the move in Leipzig and wants to get away from the daily hustle and bustle.
